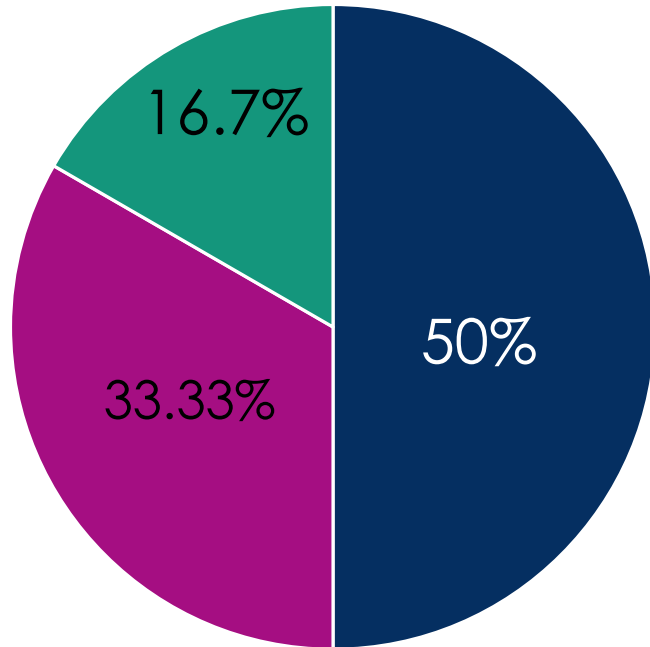

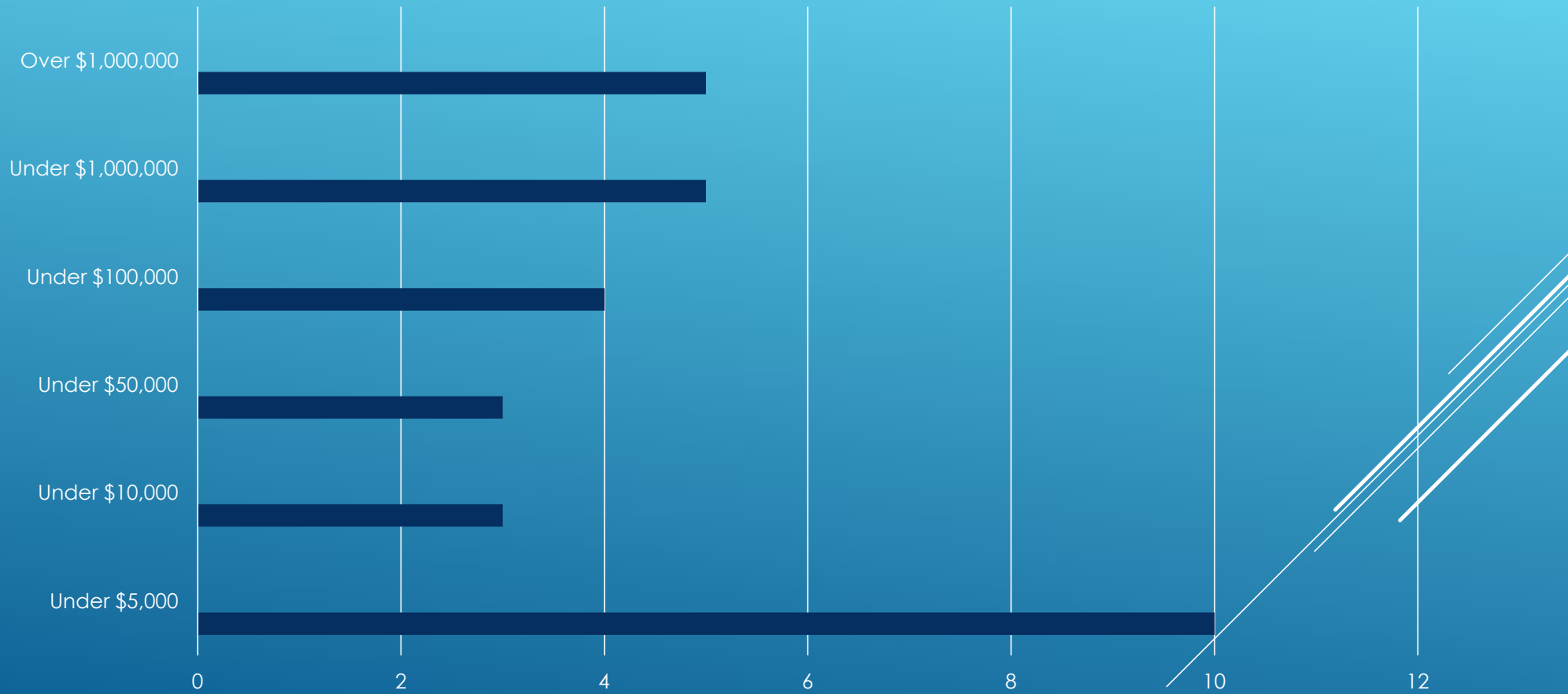

- ▶ FASD named as a condition to qualify for Special Education Services
- ▶ Mandatory FASD training for foster/adoptive parents
- ▶ FASD screening for those entering the foster system
- ▶ Increased diagnostic capacity
- ▶ Opened satellite offices
- ▶ Revived/Created FASD Task Forces
- ▶ Conducted statewide FASD needs assessments
