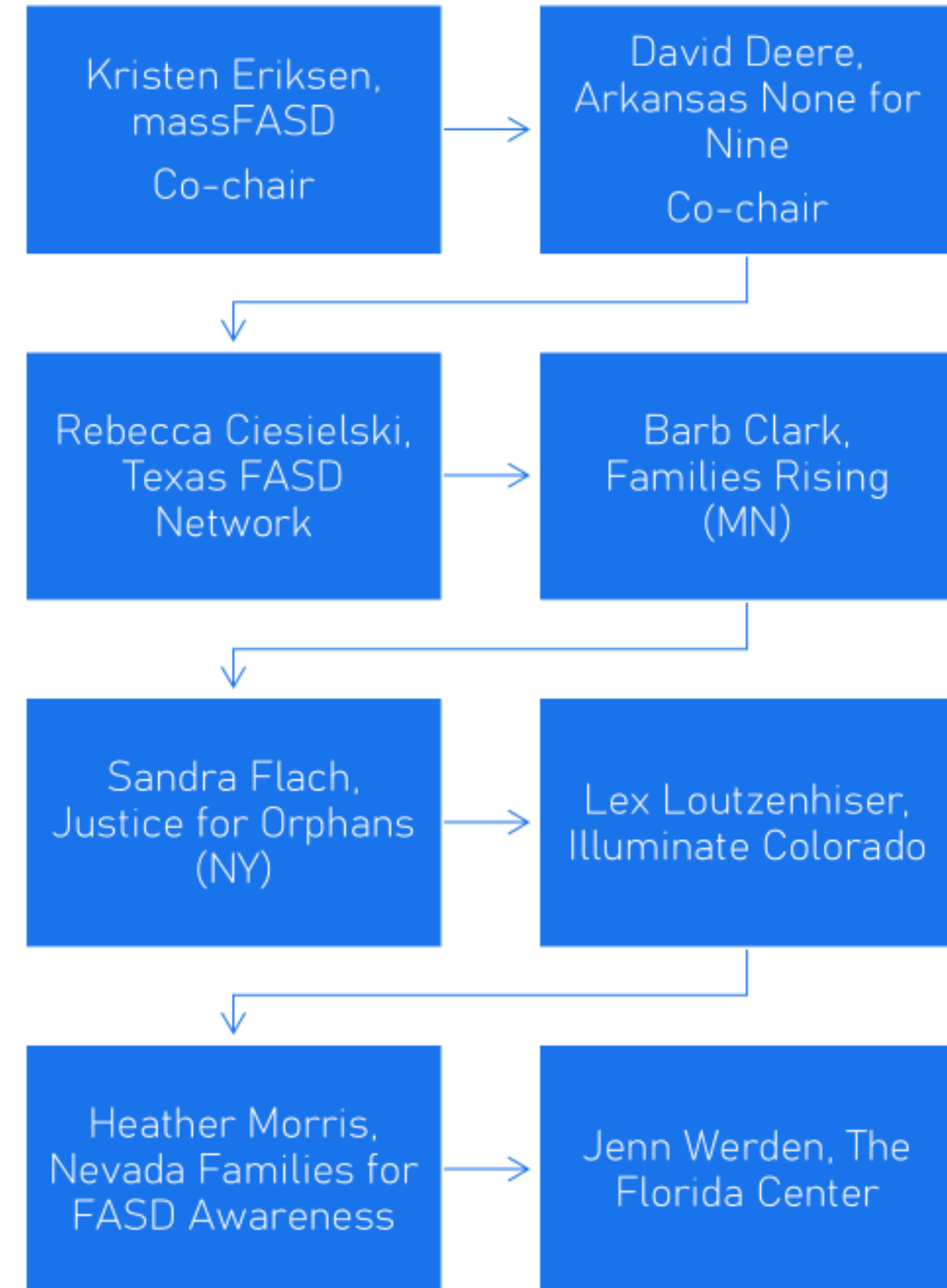

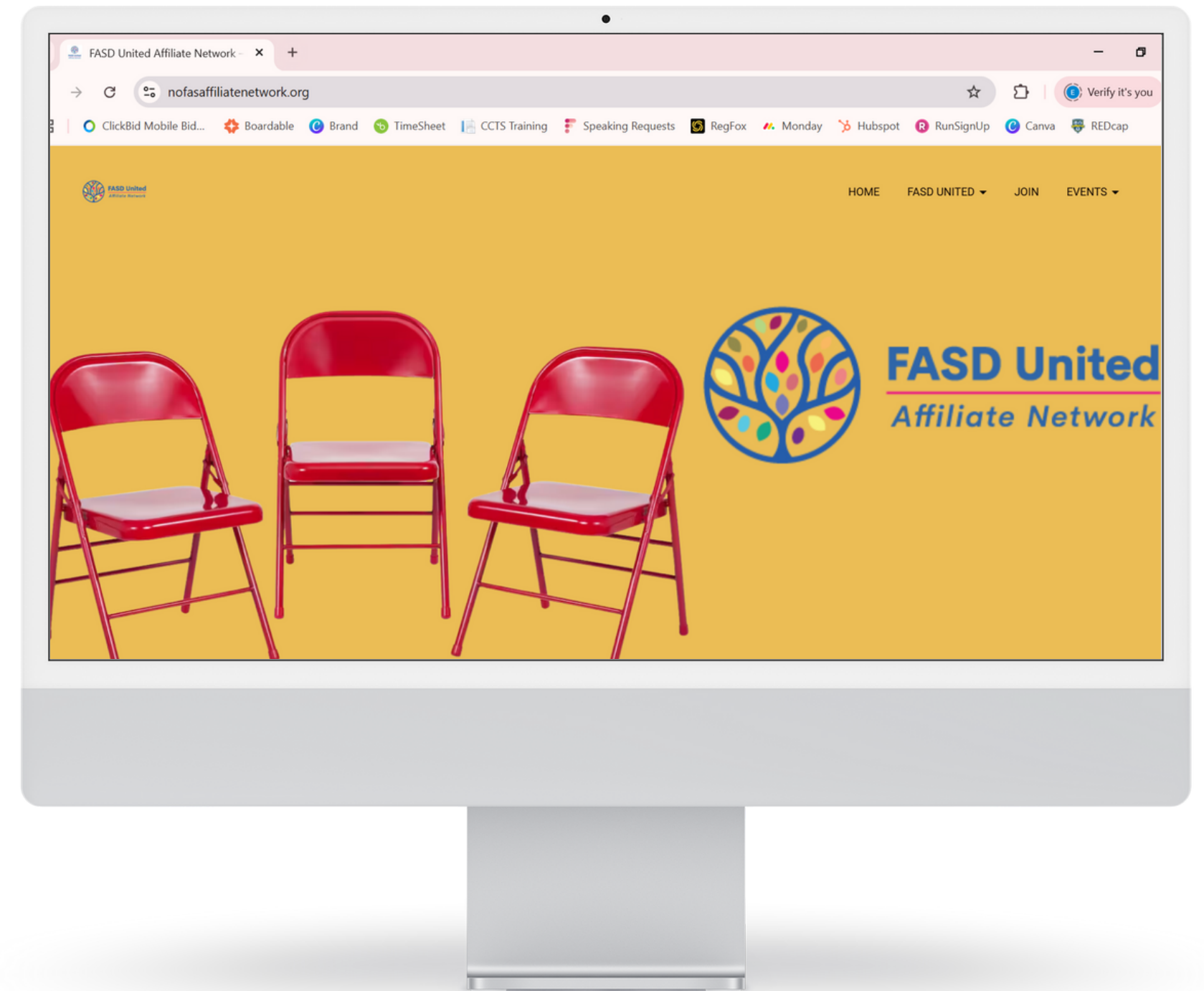


Making the Most of FASD United Resources

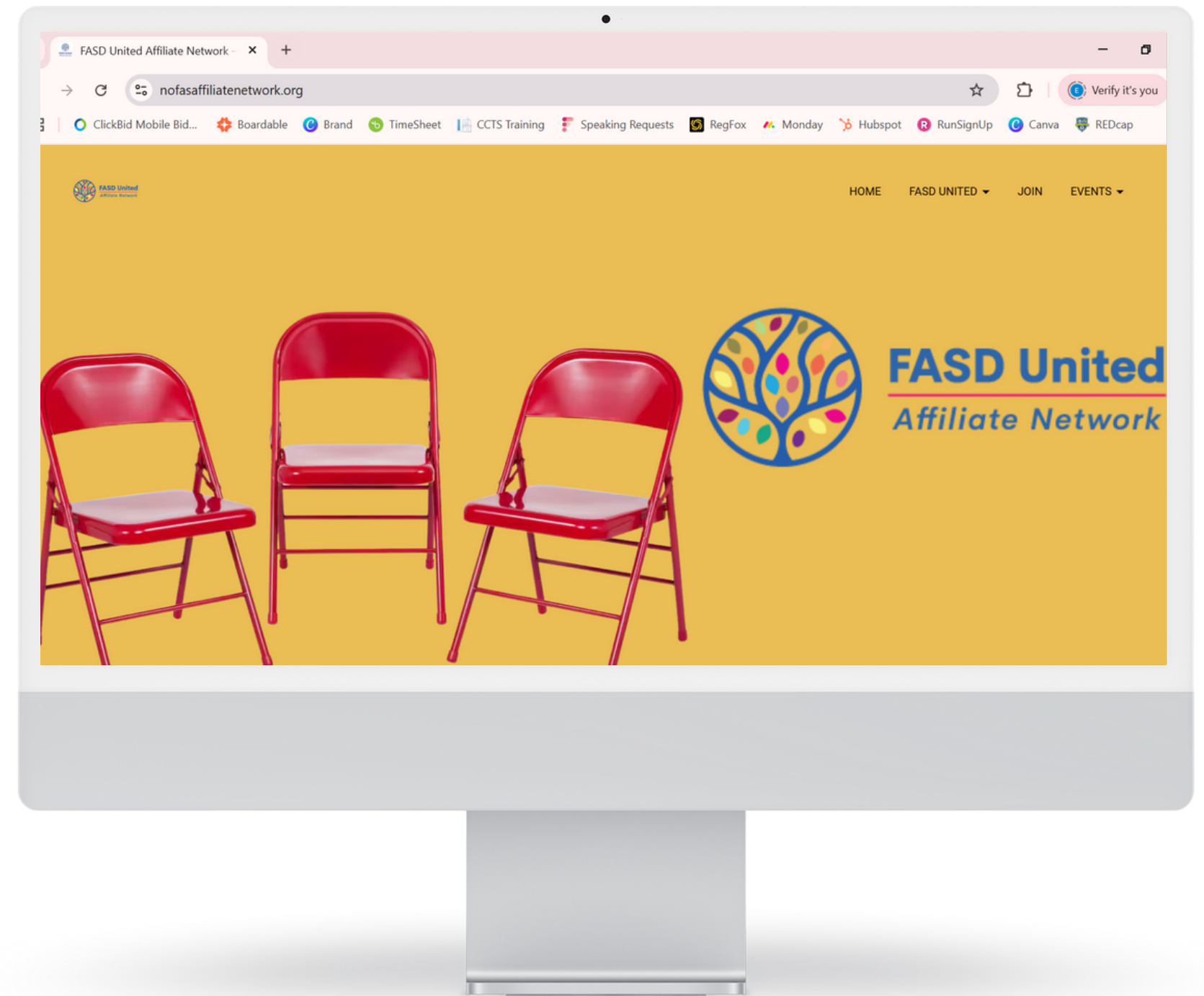

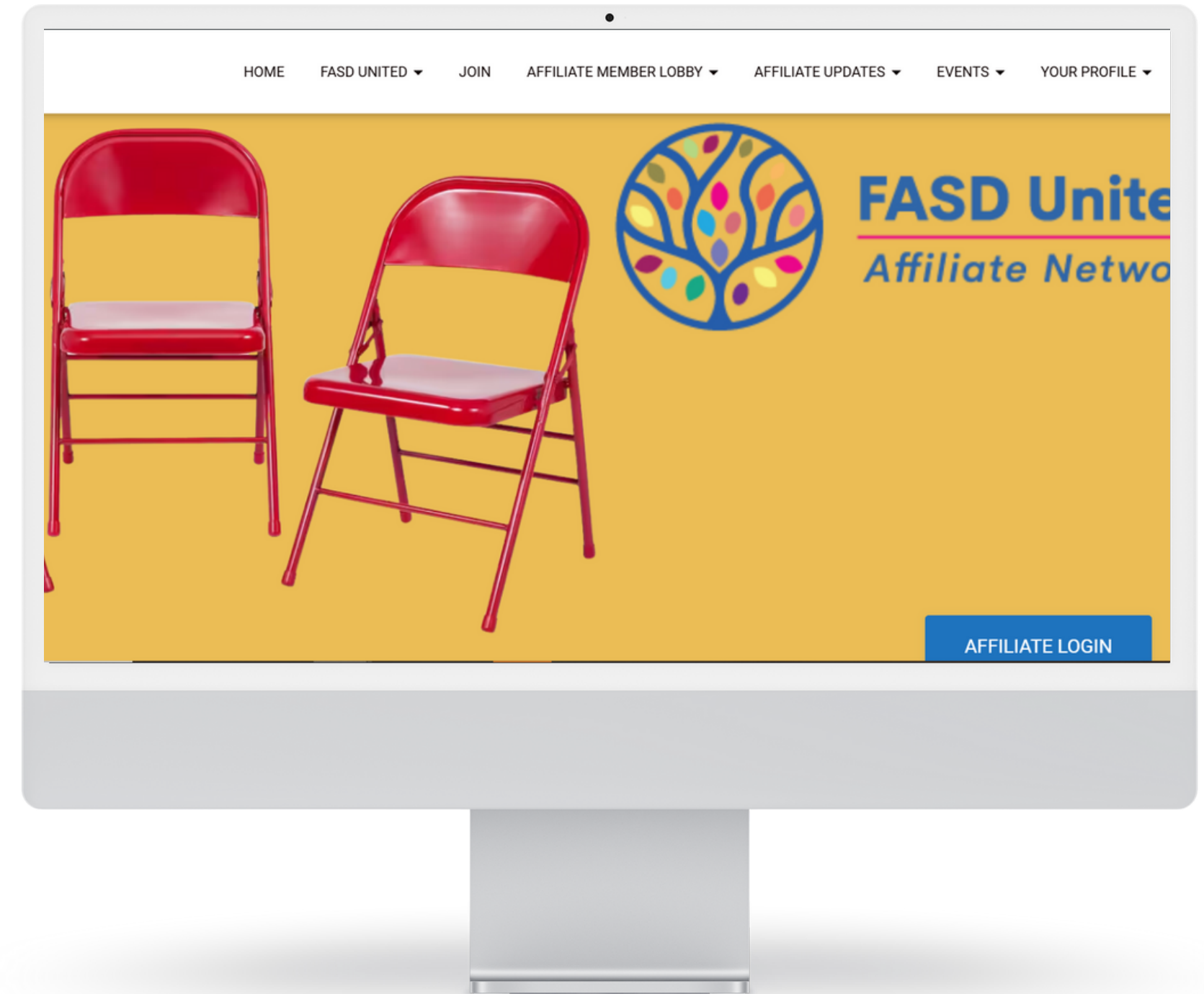

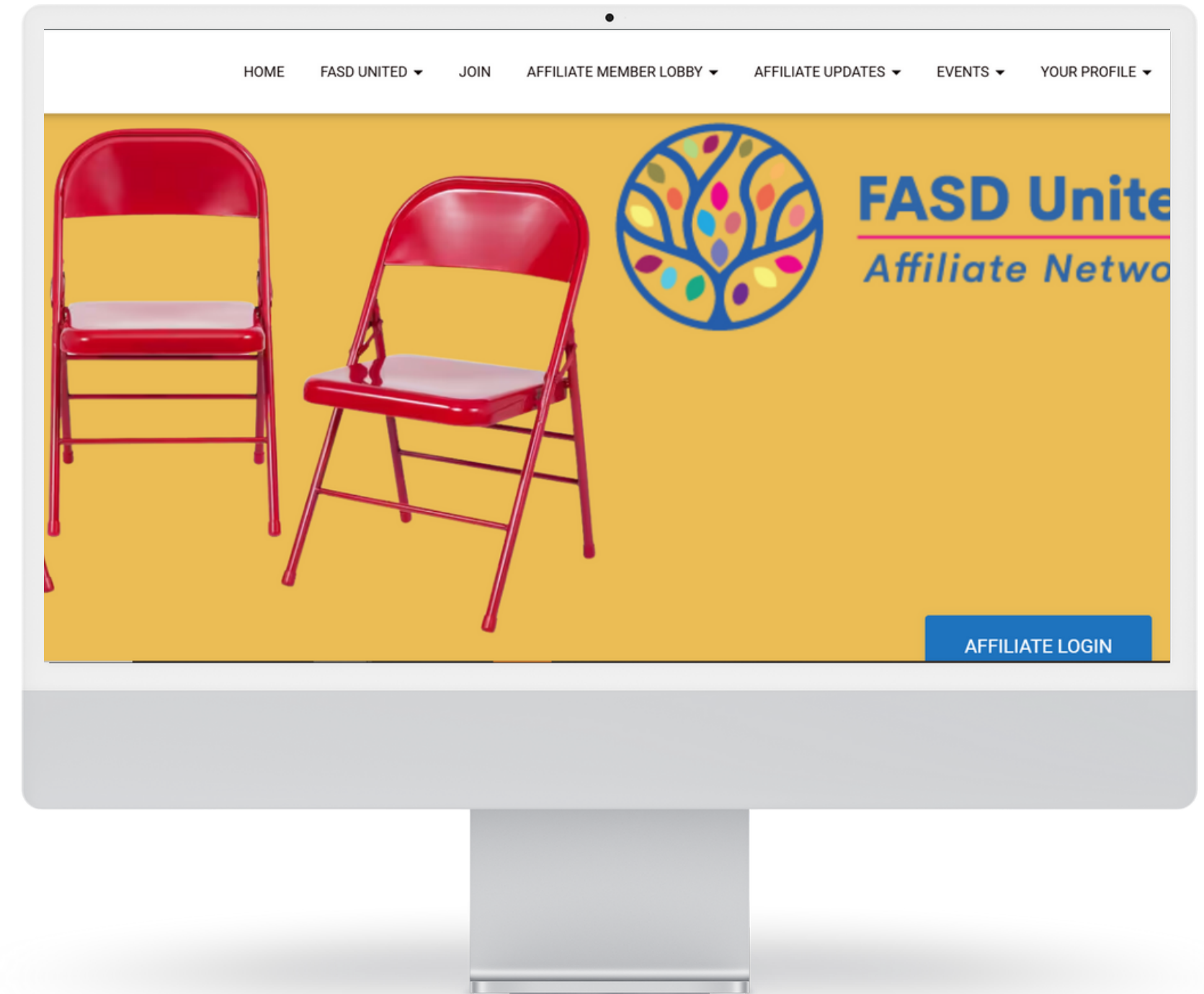
