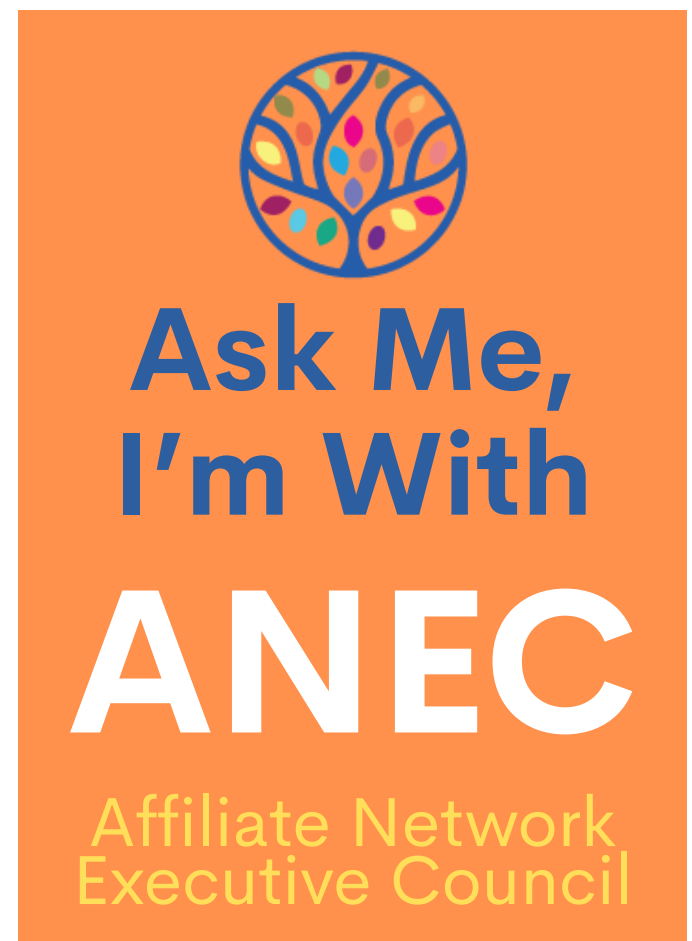

Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASDs) are a group of diagnosable medical conditions that can occur in a person who was exposed to alcohol before birth.

Effects are lifelong and can include mental health conditions, learning disabilities, sensory issues, and physical health issues such as heart defects, hearing, visual impairments, and more.

As many as **1 in 20** Americans live with FASD.

Give FASD a Seat at the Table.

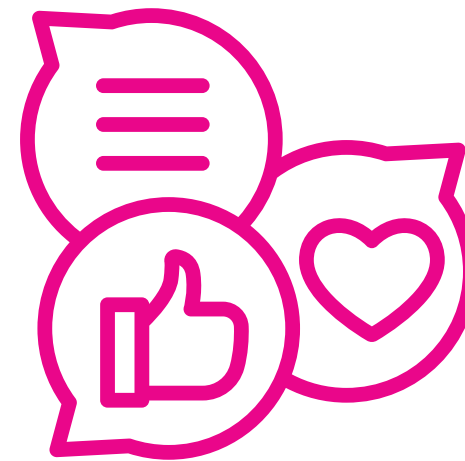

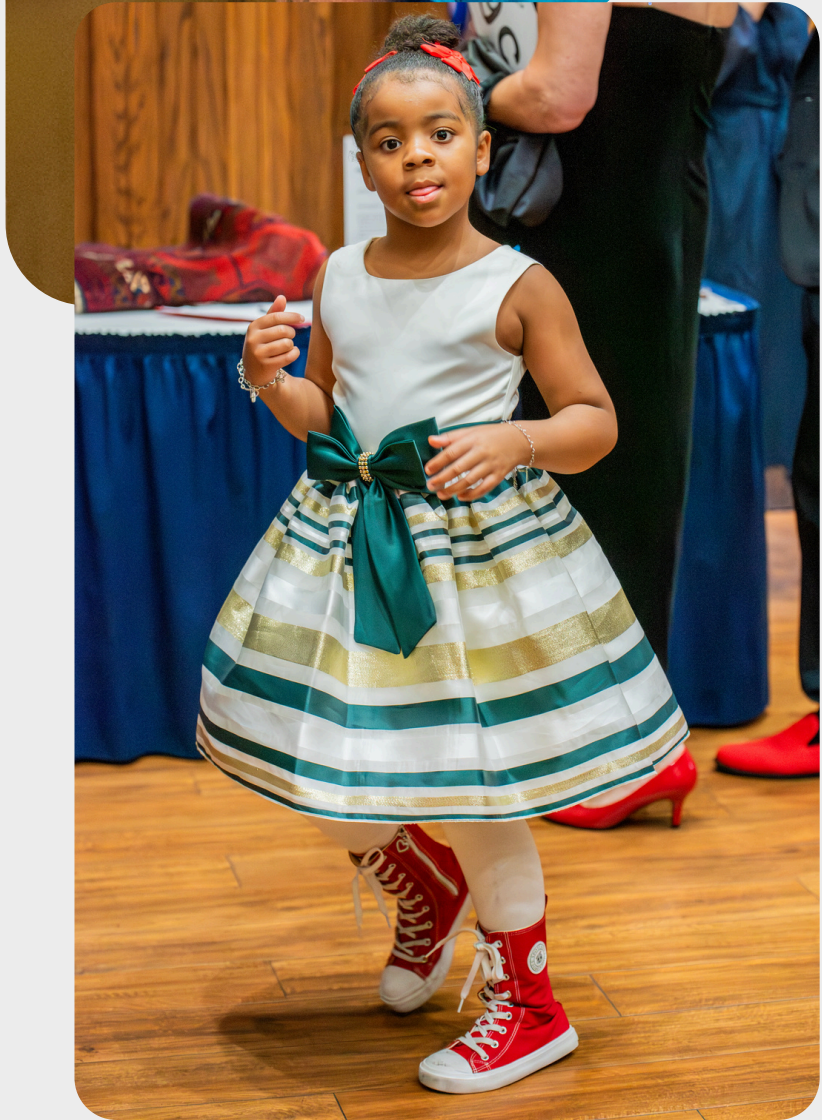

Organizational Readiness to Do Business with Your State

This tool is intended to provide initial guidance for FASD United Affiliates to ensure that their organizations are legally established, properly registered, and fully prepared to engage with their state government. This includes qualifying to apply for public funding opportunities, such as grants and contracts (RFPs), and maintaining compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

FASD United encourages Affiliates to contact your state's charity oversight office or procurement office for specific guidance. You can also contact FASD United's national office for assistance in understanding these requirements or troubleshooting issues.

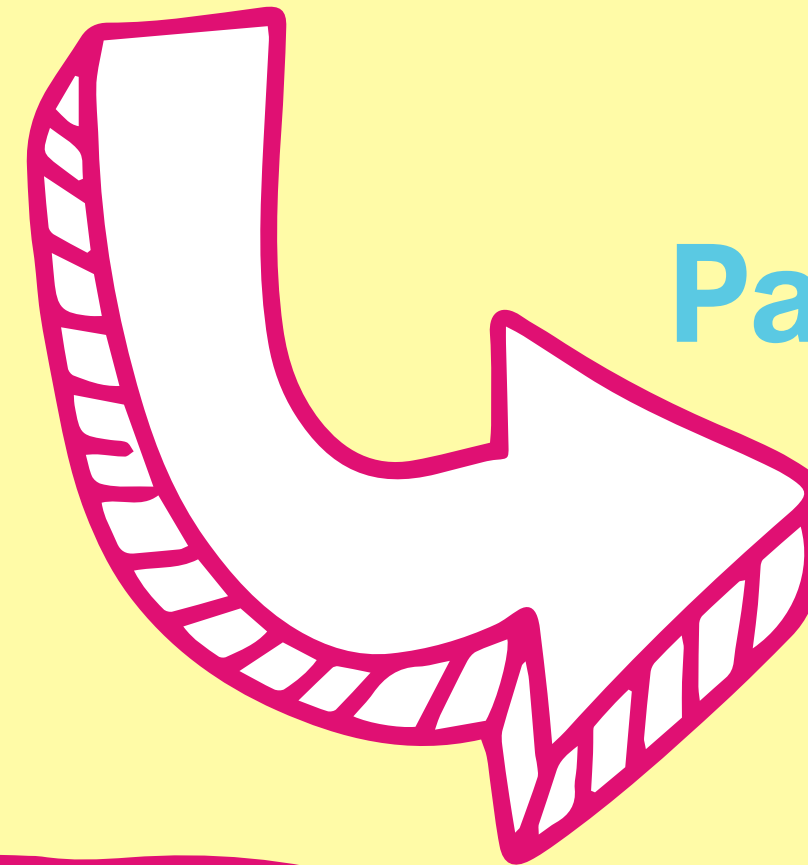

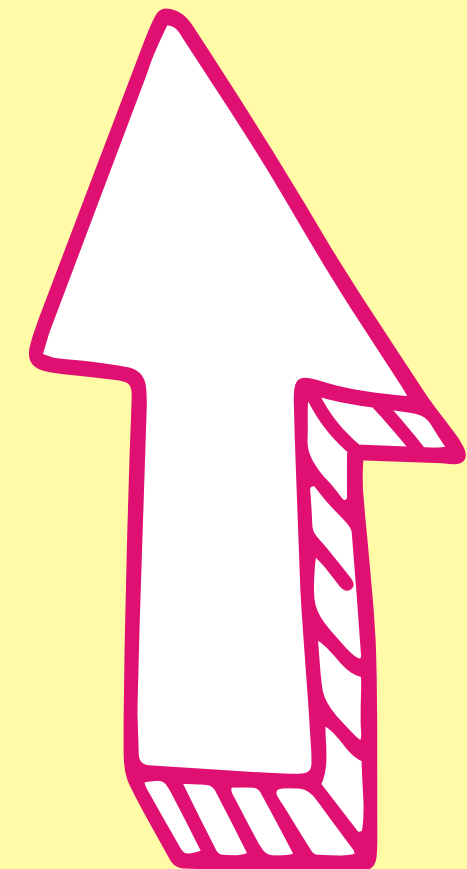
