FMF Bridges is an adaptation of the standard Families Moving Forward Foundations intervention, tailored to support infants and toddlers with prenatal alcohol exposure, with or at risk for FASD and their caregivers.

This caregiver-focused intervention is designed for implementation in community birth-to-three centers. It merges components of FASD-informed care with family-centered and relationship-based early intervention practices. FMF Bridges aims to strengthen the caregiver-child relationship, reduce
